## Peripheral Artery Disease Screen

*People with Peripheral Artery Disease or PAD are up to seven times at higher risk for heart attack and stroke.*

They often dismiss symptoms, such as fatigue, poor leg circulation and leg pain or discomfort during activity. If you are over age 50 or you have a family history of stroke or heart disease, you should be screened.

**The fee is \$60** and includes screening of the carotid artery for stroke risk, abdominal aortic aneurysm screen, peripheral arterial screening of the legs, blood work for lipids/cholesterol/glucose (4-hour fast required) and review of tests by a physician.
